Southeast Asian countries are intensifying efforts to combat domestic corruption through stronger legal frameworks. Singapore's Prevention of Corruption Act and Malaysia's MACC Act are key benchmarks, while Indonesia's Anti-Corruption Law and the Philippines' Anti-Graft and Corrupt Practices Act also bolster enforcement. Vietnam, Cambodia, and Laos have followed suit by introducing or strengthening anticorruption laws in recent years. Domestic and crossborder enforcement activity is also on the rise, however apart from Singapore, Southeast Asian countries remain at or below the CPI median score, underscoring systemic challenges to tackling corruption in this region.
