








Latin America Capability Statement

Latin American countries are enhancing their legal frameworks to address domestic corruption. Brazil's Clean Company Act and Mexico's Federal Anti-Corruption Law strengthen public accountability, while Argentina's Anti-Corruption Law, Colombia's Anti-Corruption Statute, and Peru's Anti-Corruption Law for Public Officials implement clear legal and enforcement standards. LatAm officials are increasingly empowered to prosecute high-profile corruption cases, while cross-border anti-corruption initiatives are becoming more common. Despite this progress, enforcement gaps remain, resulting in below-median CPI scores throughout the region.
